

Tracey PIRALI

Tracey Pirali is professor of Medicinal Chemistry at the University of Piemonte Orientale. After the degree in pharmacy in 2004, she gained her PhD in the laboratory of Prof. Tron. She joined the group of prof. Zhu (Paris, CNRS) and of prof. Greaney (Edinburgh, School of Chemistry) as visiting scientist. In 2013 she started her own group: her laboratory is active in drug discovery and in the translation of academic research into pharmaceutical application, especially in the field of cancer immunotherapy and orphan drugs. She co-founded ChemiCare, a spin-off company committed to the development of calcium channel modulators for the treatment of rare genetic diseases. In 2012 she was awarded the Farmindustria Prize by the Italian Chemical Society. She is a member of the Scientific Committee of the European School of Medicinal Chemistry (ESMEC) and local coordinator of the Master EMOTION, funded by the European Commission. She has authored more than 50 papers and she is the inventor of 5 patents.
